● **Fair Weather Plan**

- July 25, 2020, beginning at 11:00 a.m. @ Valley Heights High School FOOTBALL FIELD
- There will be no limitations on the number of attendees for the ceremony
- Attendees will not be allowed in the gates to the facility any earlier than 30 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony
- Families are encouraged to sit together amongst themselves
 - Seating will be available in the stands or anywhere outside of the fenceline immediately surrounding the football/track area. No entry will be allowed within the fenceline of the football field/track area
 - Please stay in your seats during the duration of the graduation ceremony. The VH journalism staff will be taking pictures of all graduates and will be shared with parents and family members.
- Social distancing guidelines are highly encouraged and expected by all attendees
- Face masks are highly recommended by all attendees
- Temperature checks at the entry gates to the football field will be required before entry into the facility
 - Any person with a temperature above 100 degrees will not be permitted into the facility
- Any person that has had a fever or other symptoms related to COVID-19 in the previous two weeks prior to graduation are encouraged to NOT attend the ceremony
- Following the ceremony, there will NOT be a processional line to congratulate all the graduates

● **Inclement Weather Plan**

- July 25, 2020, beginning at 11:00 a.m. @ Valley Heights High School GYMNASIUM
- Each graduate will receive 10 tickets to issue to family members for entry into the ceremony
 - 10 seats will be assigned for families of each graduate inside the gymnasium
 - Please stay in your seats during the duration of the graduation ceremony. The VH journalism staff will be taking pictures of all graduates and will be shared with parents and family members.
- Valley Heights will Facebook live the ceremony for other interested individuals and family members
- Attendees will not be allowed into the facility any earlier than 30 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony
