DUAL ENROLLMENT & TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Coastal Pines Technical College/CPTC

- <u>9th Graders:</u> Are NOT eligible for funded/paid for DE courses, but 9th graders can choose to self pay for courses at CPTC
- <u>10th Graders:</u> Are eligible for funded CTAE courses; To receive funding for academic courses, 10th graders must take the SAT and score a 1200 or the ACT and score a 26; 10th graders can choose to self pay for courses at CPTC
- <u>11th & 12th Graders:</u> There are currently <u>NO</u> testing requirements for 11th & 12th graders at CPTC

South Georgia State College/SGSC

- <u>9th Graders:</u> Are NOT eligible for funded/paid for DE courses
- <u>10th Graders:</u> Are eligible for funded CTAE courses; To receive funding for academic courses, 10th graders must take the SAT and score a 1200 or the ACT and score a 26
- <u>11th & 12th Graders:</u> Must take the ACT, SAT, PSAT, or Accuplacer and meet the minimum score requirements set by SGSC for admission

When Does Grade Level Eligibility Begin?

For DE purposes, a student will be classified as the next grade level upon successful completion of credits at the end of the school year. This means that most students are considered the next grade level beginning Summer Semester/May-July. Ex: This year's 10th graders will be considered 11th graders by SGSC & CPTC for Summer 2023, Fall 2023, & Spring 2024 semesters.

 - Are not eligible for DE Funding
- 10th Graders:
 - SAT: 1200
 - ACT: 26
- 11th-12th Graders:
 - SAT: Reading/Writing-480; Math-440; Math-510*
 - PSAT: Total Score-1050; Reading/Writing-480, Math-440, Math-510*
 - ACT: Reading-17; Math-17; Math-20*
 - Accuplacer:Reading-237; Writing-4; Math-258; Math-266*
