Levels of Discipline

Teachers are expected to manage student behavior in classrooms, hallways, grounds, resource rooms for all Level I and Level II misconduct. If a student's behavior becomes unmanageable or exhibits consistent misbehavior causing missed recesses, the student will be issued a discipline referral and sent to the office. The teacher will be responsible for documenting previous infractions and consequences given.

Level One

These misbehaviors are considered minor and while interrupting the educational process, are not considered serious (minor rudeness, disrespect, horseplay, inappropriate language, etc.) - taken care of at school by classroom teacher. Listed in white on Daily Behavior Log

Level Two

Misbehaviors that are frequent and tend to disrupt the school environment yet are non-violent and manageable with Positive Behavior Support (continuation of unmodified Level 1 misbehavior) Listed in white on Daily Behavior Log with documentation supporting consistency in misbehavior and parent contact has been made.

Level Three

Acts that are directed against persons or property not considered violent yet are disruptive beyond tolerance and will result in an automatic office discipline referral (behaviors listed in light gray or unmodified level 2)

Level Four

Acts which result in violence to another person or property or which pose a direct threat to the safety of others will receive an automatic office referral (behaviors listed in dark gray, unmodified level 3)

Incentive Disqualifiers (per month) (Every student needs to attend 1st assembly)

*One office referral

*Exhibits unmodified level 1 - misses recess on a consistent basis (2-3 x's a week per month)

Students with 5 losses of recess will be flagged and placed upon a list for teacher review at the end of each month. Teacher will have some discretion in deciding whether student receives incentive.
