## VT 4750 – EARLY CHILDHOOD PROFESSIONALS

Early Childhood Professionals is a one-year course designed for students who desire to work in careers involving young children PK –  $4^{TH}$  grade and their families. The course includes early child development, child health and safety, nutrition, childcare regulations, special needs children, and employment skills. Students will be responsible for planning activities that stimulate a child's mental, physical, emotional and social growth. Students will have the opportunity to use their skills through a rotation at various work sites on and off campus. Students may earn 20 hours towards the A+ tutoring requirement
