CA5113 – ENGLISH II (HONORS)

English II Honors is an accelerated course offered on an optional basis at the sophomore level. The communication skills components presented are the same as English II, but the material is more advanced. Less time is spent on basic grammar; more time is spent on application of complex grammar skills. In addition, students will be expected to deliver formal presentations, read additional novels, and write independent essays.
