### Standardized Wear Guidelines 2023-2024

ACCEPTABLE- Shirts and Tops		NON-ACCEPTABLE shirts and Tops										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Shirts must be free of inappropriate language or images.</li><li>May have 1-2 buttons undone on shirts and tops.</li><li>Shoulders and midriff covered at all times.</li><li>Sweatshirts &amp; half zip, lightweight jackets.</li></ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Hooded sweatshirts (must be stored in lockers).</li><li>Sleeveless tops and dresses, tank tops, and any top that exposes cleavage in front and/or the back skin.</li><li>Shirts worn less than full length or tied/ bound.</li></ul>										
ACCEPTABLE Pants, Skirts, Dresses and Bottoms		NON-ACCEPTABLE Pant, Skirts, Dresses and Bottoms										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Non form-fitting pants, shorts, skirts, dresses or capris. Must be worn at standard length &amp; beltline worn at the waist.</li><li>When standing, the outermost layer must be within 2 inches above the knee and cover all skin above this point.</li><li>Shorts, sweatpants, and joggers.</li></ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Form-fitting bottoms (nylon, spandex, jeggings, leggings, etc) without an acceptable outer layer.</li><li>Shorts, skirts, and dresses with slits shorter than 2” above the knee.</li><li>Sagging pants</li><li>Pajama pants</li></ul>										
ACCEPTABLE footwear		NON-ACCEPTABLE footwear										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Non-marking tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots.</li><li>Fastened sandals in front and back.</li><li>Shoes that are laced, strapped, or fastened as designed.</li><li>Heels less than 2 inches in height.</li></ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Flip flops, house slippers, unfastened and unsecured shoes.</li><li>Shoes other than tennis shoes for physical education class.</li><li>Heels higher than 2 inches.</li></ul>										
ACCEPTABLE ACCESSORIES		NON-ACCEPTABLE items
