

Invitation to Bid

Cleveland City Schools is accepting bids for 4000 to 5000 cubic yards of fill dirt located at 4445 Georgetown Road NW, Cleveland, TN 37312. Specifics of this bid can be found under CCS Bids at clevelandschools.org, or by contacting the Operations Department at (423)472-9576. Bids must be sealed and received at the Administrative Office Building of Cleveland City Schools at 4300 Mouse Creek Road NW, Cleveland, TN 37312 by 2:00 p.m. on February 5, 2020. Bids will be opened there at 2:00 p.m.

Bids will be awarded accordingly as prescribed by law, which states "Lowest and Best." A Supreme Court ruling states that the discerning of best lies solely on those requesting the bid and not the bidder. The right is also reserved to refuse any and all bids. Proposals may be held by the School Board for a period of 14 days from the date of opening for the purpose of reviewing and investigating qualifications of contractors prior to awarding the contract.

Specifications

Cleveland City Schools is taking bids to purchase approximately 4,000 cubic yards of fill dirt located at 4445 Georgetown Road NW, Cleveland, TN. The amount of fill dirt given in cubic yards is approximate and not a guarantee. Fill dirt should be bid by the cubic yard and if the highest bid chooses not to take all the available fill dirt then the next highest bid will be selected until all the available dirt is removed. Successful bidders must adhere to the following conditions:

- All equipment used for moving the fill dirt, including dump trucks, must use the gravel driveway created for access to the fill dirt. None of the trucks or equipment being used for the removal of the dirt should be driven on the asphalt driveway that enters Candy's Creek Cherokee Elementary School. In the event the successful bidder does have any equipment on the asphalt, they will be responsible for the cost of any damage caused to the driveway.
- The successful bidder is responsible for controlling the soil erosion from moving the fill dirt and keeping it from getting onto the roadway, which may include the purchasing and use of additional gravel for increasing the drive. The successful bidder is responsible for any liability incurred from moving the fill dirt, including, but not limited to, fines from municipal and/or state authorities.
- The successful bidder must schedule all times for removal of the fill dirt with the Director of Operations as to not interfere with the operation and traffic of Candy's Creek Cherokee Elementary School.
- Cleveland City Schools will determine when enough fill dirt has been removed and is under no obligation to provide a minimum amount..
