Christel Thompson, District Parent and Family Engagement Coordinator welcomed and thanked all for attendance. Introductions of all members were made. Then, Mrs. Holland, the district Food Service Manager, was introduced and she welcomed us to eat from the variety of food selections that will be offered to students in the future.

During the meal, Mrs. Holland explained the food service improvements in process throughout the district. She explained that these improvements are the direct result of parents' and students' desire to have more choice and healthy selections daily as well as an effort to avoid outsourcing food service to a third party company. She was able to answer many questions the parents had in regards to food service selections and cafeteria procedures, which included a transition to key pad entry at each point of sale. All in attendance complimented Mrs. Holland for the tasty food as well as her and her department's efforts to give students more choice in the cafeterias.

Then the high school and junior high gave reports on the two areas discussed at the fall meeting. The high school will offer two college days to juniors. After consideration and fact gathering, the high school will continue to allow students and parents to attend the two college fairs run through Ark ACRAO at U of O and Arkansas TECH. The guide to the junior high document is still in progress and ambassadors are in place. The junior high is utilizing social media, Schoology, and the website to keep parents informed and updated.
