## **Class of 2023 Google Classroom**

The high school has a google classroom dedicated to the needs of each grade level. Your student's Class of 2023 classroom contains:

# **College Applications and Scholarships**

The week of December 5 through December 9, counselors will offer a second opportunity for students to come to the cafeteria during flex for assistance with completing college, university, or trade school applications and/or scholarships.

Students need to know their social security number and complete mailing address to complete applications.

The counselors do not send transcripts. We have two registrars, Ms. Jackson and Mrs. Anderson, who send records. Students should complete the Transcript Request Form in the Class of 2023 google classroom when they need a transcript. If the transcript should be sent electronically, they will need to include an email address. Picking up a hard copy is also an option. Hard copies are available 24 hours after the request is made and are \$2 each.

### **Arkansas Scholars**

The list of senior Arkansas Scholars is posted in the Class of 2023 google classroom. Arkansas Scholars must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Complete the Smart Core Curriculum
- 2. No semester grade lower than a C weighted or unweighted
- 3. Attendance of at least 95%



If your student believes they should be on the list but are not, please have them contact their counselor.

#### **Honor Graduates**

To earn the designation of Honor Graduate, a student must have a 3.5 cumulative grade point average in the college core curriculum. The cumulative average is based on all courses taken and the GPA is not rounded up. Additionally, honor graduates **must also complete a full credit of Community Service Learning** (75 hours) and submit all required items by May 1, 2023. Due to timing, this year's seniors have some flexibility as to the organization with whom they complete their hours.

### **December 16, 2022**

Last day before Winter Break. There are no semester exams! It is a regular school day and attendance will be taken as normal.

## January 20, 2023

Friday, January 20, 2023 is the last day of the FIRST semester. Because of the timing, we will not have semester exams. Student grades will be an average of the first nine weeks and second nine weeks marks. We will have second semester exams in May.

**Academic Signing** is an end-of-the-year senior event sponsored by the North Little Rock Public Education Foundation. The honorees, chosen from the graduating seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.8 or better (in the college core) and/or the designation as a National Merit Scholar, will be selected based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- Be the recipient of one of the top scholarships from their college/university of choice
- Be the winner of a state or national academic scholarship program (i.e. Governor's Distinguished, National Merit Finalist)
- Be appointed to a service academy
- Be accepted to a highly selective institution

Those selected to participate receive a FORMAL invitation. Not all students who meet the initial criteria will be selected to participate.

#### June 1, 2023

Graduation will be held at the Jack Stephens Center located on the campus of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock. The ceremony will begin at 7:00 p.m. and each graduate will be allowed six (6) guests; infants will count as one of the six permitted.

All graduates must wear a cap, gown, and tassel purchased through Jostens. Only items issued by the school may be worn with the graduation gown.
