Course Description

Prerequisite: Passing Grade from the Level II Course

Spanish III provides instruction that enables the student to understand and appreciate other cultures. Students will compare their behavioral patterns and values with that of the target language. Students will be able to initiate and participate in discussions concerning both cultures. In addition, students will be able to:

- respond to questions and interact in a variety of social situations, such as expressing regrets, condolences and complaints;
- read for comprehension a variety of authentic materials, such as advertisements in newspapers and magazines, cartoons and personal correspondence;
- read short literary selections of poetry, plays and short stories;
- complete authentic forms and documents, and take notes that require familiar vocabulary and sentence structure;
- to describe different aspects of the culture, using the target language when appropriate. These aspects include: 1) major historical events; 2) political structures; 3) value systems; 4) visual arts; 5) architecture; 6) literature and 7) music, etc.;
- to learn how to use the target language in crisis situations;
- to participate appropriately at special, family occasions such as birthdays, weddings, funerals and anniversaries, as well as the "Quinceañera".
