Good afternoon everyone,

Monday, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine signed an order extending K – 12 building closures through May 1, 2020. He will reevaluate that date as it draws closer.

The Governor was candid saying it is possible that date could be extended as the COVID-19 virus is not expected to peak here in Ohio until mid to late April. Monday's announcement came on the heels of President Trump's order Sunday night that the country continue to shelter-in-place for another 30 days.

In the meantime, we will continue with online instruction, while recognizing a true Spring Break next week, April 6-10, 2020. Students will not be assigned work next week and teachers are not expected to reply to email. **Online courses will resume on Monday, April 13.**
