- Online instruction begins Tuesday, March 17, 2020. This instruction is self-paced with teachers available for questions via email between 8 am and 3 pm Monday - Friday. Students are not expected to be online during the entirety of the day. We understand individual situations may require some students to complete their work in the evening. If you submit a question after 3 pm, our staff will do its best to answer you in a timely manner. It may be the following school day.

- We know that many of you are concerned about meals for your students. Last Friday, we filed the necessary paperwork with USDA in order to provide those meals. We are awaiting approval. Once we receive that, we will share our detailed plan internally and externally. Because we have never served what is referred to as "summer meals" we had to formally request permission to do so.
- The third 9-week grading period will end Friday, March 20, 2020. Student report cards will be mailed home once grades are finalized.
- Please note that all school buildings will be closed after 3:00 pm daily until further notice. No activities will be taking place in our facilities or on our grounds, as directed by Governor DeWine this past weekend.
