St. Joseph High School College Day Release Form

St. Joseph seniors will be given the opportunity to attend college day activities; to review programs at colleges, vocational schools, and business colleges; and to discuss scholarships and financial aid, admission requirements, and the curriculum to various schools.

- The seniors will be given two (2) days during the school year to visit those campuses. These days can be used together or separately.
- Prior arrangements must be made through the counselor's office (Mrs. Davis).
- No College Days will be scheduled after April 25.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Students must return the form to Mrs. Davis <u>no later than 2 days before</u> their College Day.
- 2. Students must turn in a proof of college visit form <u>from the college (on college letterhead or some sort of school form)</u>, <u>signed by a college representative</u>, to the high school office upon returning to school in order for the absence to be counted as a College Day. *Colleges will have this ready during your visit if you ask*. Turning in the form late will result in that day being counted as an absence.
- 3. Students are responsible for getting assignments from their teachers before taking a College Day.
