

Greetings CUSD#1 Parents & Guardians,

Illinois Law (105 ILCS 128/20.c) requires schools to complete a lockdown drill in conjunction with Law Enforcement to address a school shooting incident. This lockdown drill addressing an active threat or an active shooter within a school building must be completed within 90 Calendar days after the first day of school to evaluate the preparedness of school personnel and students.

According to the statute, the Law Enforcement lockdown drill must be conducted on days and times when students are normally present in the school building and must involve participation from all school personnel and students present at school at the time of the lockdown drill.

Illinois also allows you to OPT your child out of the drill if you so choose. Your child will still be required to complete training on active shooters; however, it will be completed on an individual basis.

The Drill will be conducted the week of October 24<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>.
