## Reopening

These document state what districts must do and also provide guidance when there is flexibility for local solutions. Our Reopening Committee will be sending a survey at the beginning of next week to get input from parents/guardians and your children. Of particular interest for our planning is to have an understanding of how many students will accept the option to continue with distance learning. Another piece of important information will be to know how many students who do return to school will also ride the school buses.

## **Summer Meal Program Reminder**

We have received a waiver to continue with the meal program for July and August. This will start July 1 and end on August 21. See below for new summer days and times.

**ALL** students of the Lebanon Public Schools and **ALL** school age children, including non-Lebanon residents, are eligible to receive free meal packages. The children do not have to be present at meal pick up. It is OK to have someone do the pick-up for you.
