OPEN FORUM

The "Open Forum" is a means whereby patrons of the School District may address the school board on school issues.

The following are guidelines for the Open Forum:

- 1. "Open Forum" is declared by the chairman and the chairman may establish criteria for presentations.
- 2. Anyone present may address the Board on relevant school issues;
- 3. The presenter may address the Board only once on a single issue; unless the presenter has additional information on the issue.
- 4. This is not a time for debate or rebuttal;
- 5. Questions for clarification may be asked by Board members and/or administration;
- 6. The person presenting will address the chairman;
- 7. The Board will take no action during the "Open Forum" session;
- 8. When the Board returns to its agenda, they shall determine which subjects (as a result of the open forum) will be agenda items for the next regular or special meeting.
