Parts of the brain:

Cerebrum: (made up of 2 Hemispheres)- Right Cerebral Cortex & Left Cerebral Cortex)

Right: Creativity, artistic ability, responsible for body's thought and actions.

Left: Language, crucial skills like learning, reasoning, calculating mathematically, and reading and writing.

Limbic system: emotions and memory Cerebellum: balance and movement Brain Stem: controls involuntary actionsbreathing, blinking, digestion, heart rate.
