#### **Trainer and Emergency Care**

Trinity will have our trainer on-site at the field in case of any injuries. The trainer will be available for taping one hour before game time. Ice and water will be available before, during, and after the game.

#### **Parking**

- **Bus** The player bus can drop the team off as marked in yellow on the attached map. (In the back of Trinity School, off Godfrey Street.) A coach will meet the bus and escort the team to their locker room.
- Fans Spectator parking is available on the east side of Trinity school off Godfrey Street. Please enter through the open gate. Please do not park in front of the school on Wadley Ave. (turn right at the light onto Godfrey Street.)
- **Rosters** please send the football team roster, cheer squad roster, or any group you want to be announced with coaches, managers, trainer, principal, and Head of School to the Athletic Administrative Assistant Denessa Leary by Tuesday the week of the game: *dleary@trinitymidland.org*.
- TICKETS: Admission is free. Trinity does not charge for spectators.

#### **Locker Room**

Your team will be in the Heck Gym building locker room. They will be escorted to the locker room by Coach Willis. There is a dry-erase board with markers and an eraser. In addition, there is an ice machine (if needed)-please let Coach Willis know upon your arrival.

#### Visitor/Cheerleader/Band

The seating for the home team is on the east side. Visitors are also welcome to sit in the stands on the east side. If visitors would like to sit on the west side, there are no bleachers; please let your visitors know they need to bring chairs. Due to limited space, you'll want to be creative with how you provide space for your cheer squads and your band. There is no seating beyond the end zones for these groups. Trash receptors will be placed on the visitors' side.

#### **Halftime Programs**

Please notify Steve McCarthy at least one week before the game day if your cheerleaders and band would like to perform at halftime. Your program should be a maximum of 7 minutes and begin immediately at the end of the second quarter. The Trinity halftime program will follow your program.

#### **Restroom Facilities**

Restroom facilities are located on the west side of the concession stand building.

#### **Emergency Procedures**

- If lightning is present before or during the game, all parties will be moved to their vehicles or indoors. The event will only be resumed if 30 minutes have passed since the last visual evidence of lightning.
- Game officials are responsible for declaring a weather delay or cancellation.
- The game announcer will announce any emergencies with instructions on where to relocate.

Trinity will employ 1-2 uniformed officers from the Midland County Sheriff's or The City of Midland Police Department to be on-site before, during, and after the game for traffic control and security.

#### **Concessions**

Trinity will have a concession stand open with hot dogs, candy, snacks, and drinks.

#### **General Restrictions**

- No live animal mascots, cannons, firearms, fireworks, etc.
- No dogs or other animals
- No sound systems other than the official announcer's system
- No body paint or decoration by players or spectators (small markings as sold by school organizations are permitted on the cheek)
- No streamers, confetti, or other materials
- No air horns or bull horns, handheld or otherwise
- No use of or the appearance of using any controlled substance (alcohol, drugs, etc.) before, during, or after games
