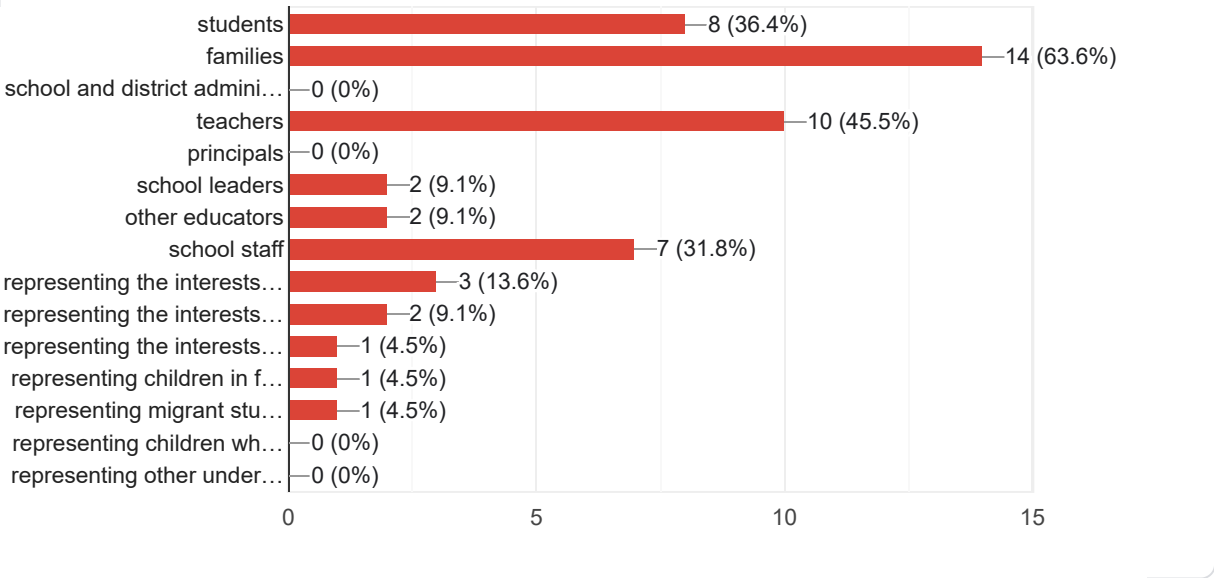

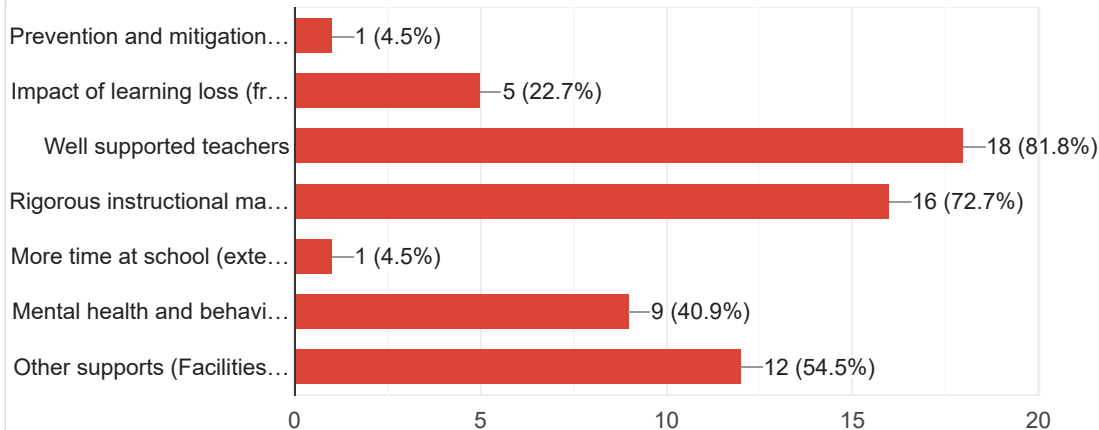

Which of these options is important to you? Please check all that apply.



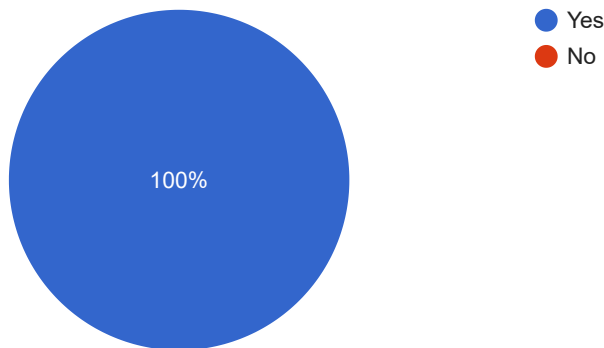
