Explanation: The town's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from Pre-Kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act is the amount of money determined by state law to be the minimum amount that the town must raise in order to receive the full amount of state dollars.

**Art. XIV:** Shall the Town of Easton raise and appropriate \$1,348,611.69 in additional local funds, which exceeds the State's Essential Programs and Services allocation model by \$1,348,611.69 as required to fund the budget recommended by the School Board?

The School Board recommends \$1,348,611.69 for additional local funds and gives the following examples of reasons for exceeding the State's Essential Programs and Services funding model by \$1,348,611.69

- 1. Next years' cost for all regular faculty and staff salaries/benefits in the Easton Schools is over \$901,245 above what the EPS Model recognizes.
- 2. Next years' cost for all Special Education/Gifted & Talented is over \$64,600 above what the EPS Model recognizes.
- 3. Next years' cost for Operations/Maintenance is over \$152,370 above what the EPS Model recognizes.

Explanation: The additional local funds are those locally raised funds over and above the town's local contribution to the total cost of funding public education from pre-kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act. Local amounts raised for the annual payment on non-state funded debt service will help achieve the school department budget for educational programs.
