The school year didn't end the way we had planned, but we have made the best of the situation. Take a look at how our students, teachers, staff and families have continued to learn and teach!




“Zoom” School

Mrs. Shada Hamilton met with her 5th grade students in a zoom session. Several teachers used this technology to reach out to their students!






Above: Jacey, a 4th grader at CES, working on her AMI packet!


CES + CLC Virtual Spirit Week

Let's show our spirit even though we are apart!









CES 1st grader Graylan showed his appreciation to essential workers!
