

Health Requirement Chart

Meningitis vaccine is required for 6th and 12th grades. If the student did not receive their first meningitis vaccine before the age of 16, they will not need a second vaccine as a senior.

If you are not sure if your child has had their shots or not, you need to contact your physician or Bi-County (wherever you usually get your child's shots) and find out if they still need it. Shots are usually due at Kindergarten, 6th, and 12th grades.

If your child is going into a grade that requires a school physical, you will not need to get a sport physical. The school physical will also count as their sports physical. However, a sports physical cannot count as a school physical.

If your child has asthma, an allergy that may or may not require the use of an epi-pen, diabetes, blood disorders, or any other major health concern, then your child will require an emergency action plan to be signed by the doctor. Keep that in mind as you are scheduling appointments for your child and remember to take all the forms with you to the appointment. Please contact me if you need any of these forms to take with you to the physician and I will leave the correct forms for you with Ms. Bowman in the front office.
