A MESSAGE FROM DR. LIND ABOUT RE-OPENING

Now that we are in Phase 4 of the Governor's Reopen Illinois plan, Nippersink SD 2 and Richmond-Burton CHSD 157 can begin to prepare for the upcoming school year. Part of the Governor's Phase 4 plan requires all public and private schools in Illinois to implement health mandates created by the Illinois State Board of Education and Illinois Department of Public Health. These requirements will include wearing of masks, temperature/symptom checks each day, maintaining social distancing of 6 feet whenever possible, a limit to 50 people in a specific space at one time and enhanced cleaning procedures.

To assist in the implementation of these requirements and to plan for a successful return to school, we have created a task force made up of students, parents, staff and administrators. This task force will be examining potential schedules for in person learning while working to improve our remote learning plans should we need to return to them. Through July and early August, we will continue to send updates in order to help students and families prepare for the upcoming school year.

Finally, both districts want to thank everyone for working with us during these difficult times. It is a team effort, and keeping our students safe and healthy is our number one goal.

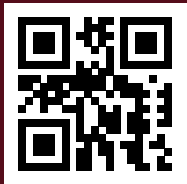
