Sponsorship of Special Events Being Hosted By The District

To defray the costs to the District associated with hosting special events, the School Board may approve sponsorship or underwriting by corporate or non-profit entities, subject to the rules and regulations which govern school-owned properties, and the appropriateness of the sponsorship to the District's operations and educational objectives. Sponsorship by any entity whose sole¹ or principal² purpose is the production or sale of materials or services not suitable for use by students, such as alcohol or tobacco products, shall not be authorized. Those businesses licensed as an accessory use with another permitted business as the principal at the same location are exempt. Accessory use may be determined in the same manner required under any ordinance of the City of Pekin or any law of the State of Illinois.

¹ Sole – being the only one; single.

² Principal – the capital of a financial holding as distinguished from the revenue from it.
