Grades 7, 8 and 9 are organized as secondary grades for the provision of departmentalized instruction.

Teaching staff members assigned to teach in grade nine must possess an instructional certificate and the subject matter endorsement appropriate to the academic subject to which they are assigned.

Teaching staff members assigned to teach in grades 7 or 8 must possess an instructional certificate with an elementary teacher's endorsement.

The Superintendent shall continually monitor the effectiveness of the district organizational plan and recommend to the Board such modifications in the plan as may be in the best interest of pupils, make most effective use of district resources, and serve the educational goals of the Board.
