

Dear Parents and Guardians,

On Friday, June 26, 2020, Governor Murphy shared the plan for schools to reopen in September. Please see the attached document with guidance for school districts to follow as we plan for a safe return of our students.

In an effort for Englewood to plan accordingly for the reopening of our schools in September, we are asking for your help by completing this survey. The Englewood Task Force Committee is planning for several possible scenarios, including in-person instruction, distance learning, and a hybrid of both. The survey is not a vote on which scenario will be used but is a tool for us to determine how our school community feels about the possible scenarios. The decision about which scenario to use will be guided by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) requirements.

Englewood Public Schools is currently planning our return for the 2020-2021 school year based on three different options:

**In-Person Learning:** A return to face-to-face instruction in the school building, while practicing social distancing and recommending PPE. We would follow all recommendations for cleaning and sanitizing the school building.

**Distance Learning:** A continuation of distance learning at home.

**Hybrid Learning:** A blended model of instruction that uses both in-person Learning and distance learning Days.
