2:00 – 8:00 p.m.

#### I. Qualifications for Voters:

- A. a citizen of the United States;
- B. at least (18) eighteen years of age;
- C. a district resident for at least (30) days prior to the vote.

#### II. Qualifications of School Board Members:

- A. must be able to read and write;
- B. must be a qualified voter of the district (see previous section);
- C. must be and have been a district resident for at least one year prior to the election, but need not be a taxpayer;
- D. may be the only member of his/her family (defined as those within the same household) on such school board;
- E. may not be an employee of such school board;
- F. may not simultaneously hold another, incompatible public office;
- G. must not have been removed from a school district office within one (1) year of the election.

### III. What are the steps to the voting process:

- A. Sign your legal name, print your name and address, to include the name of a road or street (not post office box) in the official voting poll book.
- B. Show the inspector one form of proof of residency which may include, but is not limited to, a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card.
- C. Upon the signal from an inspector, enter the voting area.
