


State Distribution of Overall School ESSA Index Scores







Distribution of School-Level Weighted Achievement Scores




The score 81.1 falls in the 80-85 bar of the state distribution of the weighted achievement score for the Middle Level grade span.








School Value-added Growth Score Plotted with Weighted Achievement for Subgroups









Distribution of School-Level Value-Added Growth Scores







State Distribution of School-Level Overall SQSS Scores



Each measure focuses on the extent to which students are meeting important educational milestones (such as reading proficiently), important readiness criteria (minimum ACT score of 19 for Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship), and important postsecondary success indicators (attainment of AP, IB, concurrent credits).

Percent of Points Earned for Student Engagement










Percent of Points Earned for Reading at Grade Level







State Distribution of School-Level Science Achievement




