The History of Logansport High School

The city of Logansport's school history begins in March 1829 with a one-story, two-room schoolhouse at the corner of Fourth and Market Streets known as the Eel River Seminary. On August 11, 1840, the Cass County and Eel River Seminary Association bought a square plot of ground from the estate of General John Tipton. The plot of land was bordered by Thirteenth and Fourteenth Streets, and by Broadway and Market Streets.

The New Seminary (#1), a three-story stone building, was erected at the corner of Thirteenth and Broadway Streets in 1848-49. It opened for the school year in September of 1849. High school classes were first offered in Logansport at the Seminary in 1863, when a system dividing the school children into four categories – primary, intermediate, grammar and high school – was implemented. The first recorded high school commencement took place June 1, 1871, at the Mesodion Opera House, located over Porter's Drug Store. The first graduates were Miss Ann Covalt, Miss Sallie Horn, and Miss Sadie Clendenning.

In 1873 the Seminary was deeded to the city of Logansport. The following year, 1874, the Seminary was razed, and a new structure was erected on the same site. This building, known as Central or Lincoln School (#2), conducted high school classes from 1874 to 1894.

The Roosevelt Building (#3), located at the corner of Seventh and Broadway Streets, became the high school from 1894 through 1913.

In 1913 the Lincoln School was torn down to make room for the "old" Logansport High School (#4), which operated for sixty years on the Broadway site.

The course of building a new high school was first embarked on in 1967. The decision to build the "new" high school was the result of a recommendation from a physical plant survey committee in April 1967. It was on May 8, 1967, that the Board of School Trustees voted to build a new school. In November of that same year, the board agreed to purchase land for the school. In February 1968 the board voted to purchase the property where the high school is now located. Although there was some trimming in the proposed cost of the building, it was completed and classes started in 1973.

The "new" Logansport High School #5 at 1 Berry Lane was constructed on a hilltop on the eastern edge of Logansport on 86 acres of land. The building was divided into four sections; an athletic wing, a student services wing, and two academic wings.

The original athletic wing includes the Berry Bowl, which provides seating for 5,830 people, and the 400-seat, six-lane swimming pool. In addition to the standard locker room facilities, the athletic facility also includes a wrestling room. Outside arenas include Jim Turner Baseball Field, Fincher Softball Field, ten tennis courts, and the "Berry Patch," a wooded area used by the students of LHS as an outdoor classroom. The football stadium and track area were constructed in 1950. They are located behind the current administration building on George Street within two blocks of the high school.

Dr. Scott Phillips

Hall of Distinction

The 2023 Logansport High School Hall of Distinction inductee is 1982 graduate Dr. Scott Phillips.

Dr. Phillips attended Butler University before completing his medical degree at Indiana University School of Medicine. During his time at IU, he joined the United States Air Force, which led to his distinguished career as a Flight Surgeon. Dr. Phillips participated in several military operations, including Operation Desert Storm, and was involved in humanitarian assistance missions such as Operation Provide Comfort in Turkey and care for Cuban refugees at Guantanamo Bay.

Following his military career, Dr. Phillips completed his residency and became Chief of Otolaryngology at Scott Air Force Base near St. Louis. While there, he was selected to serve as a NASA Space Shuttle Rescue Team flight surgeon and was on the rescue team of 22 Space Shuttle missions, including the Shuttle's final flight. He was promoted to Deputy Chief of Bioastronautics, where he assisted with rescue plans for future NASA missions. He also participated in the Air Force reserves at Grissom Air Force Base as a refueling squadron flight surgeon for 14 years.

Dr. Phillips retired from the Air Force in 2015 after serving a total of 28 years, and he continues to serve as an aeromedical consultant for both the FAA and NASA. Dr. Phillips has completed his Fellowship in Otolaryngic Allergy and has focused practice at the Center for Ear Nose Throat and Allergy in the areas of Pediatric Ear Nose and Throat Disorders and Nasal Health.

Dr. Phillips also enjoys teaching and is an adjunct professor at the Indiana University School of Medicine and Marian University College of osteopathic medicine. He teaches residents from the Indiana University Otolaryngology program and those in family practice and pediatric residencies at St. Vincent's and Community Hospital's training programs, as well as medical students from Marian University in Indianapolis. He is also a clinical instructor for several education classes, including Advanced Trauma Life Support, Advanced Cardiac Life Support, and Combat Casualty Care.

Dr. Phillips has presented at numerous national and international meetings, published a textbook chapter and several papers in medical literature, and is currently active in medical research. Dr. Phillips has proudly served his community as a member of the Lion's Club and as the physician for his local law enforcement Special Response/SWAT team.

Felix the Cat

Felix the Cat is the oldest recognized mascot in the state of Indiana and graduates of Logansport High School have always taken a lot of pride with the uniqueness that Felix brings to the rich history of LHS.

There are a few versions of how this famous feline came to fruition through the years.

According to the 1941 Tattler, "In 1926, Coach Cliff Wells presented a little red and black cat to Raymond "Curly" Hupp. Immediately, this stuffed feline was christened, Felix." For several weeks, Felix was held captive in a gym locker. But one evening, when an important game was going badly, Felix was taken from the locker and placed in the center of the floor. The Berries were victorious, and thus Felix became our mascot and the first 'official' basketball mascot in Indiana."

Another version that is much more detailed was told by Ralph "Red" Tucker in 1996. Tucker played for Wells and with Hupp. According to this story, the date was March 31, 1926, and sixteen members of the Logansport High School basketball team were on their way to a post season banquet at the Barnes Hotel in downtown Logansport. Accompanied by their coach, Cliff Wells, they were entering the hotel when they spotted a small stuffed cat made of oilcloth in a store window.

This replica of Felix the Cat was in Logan's school colors, red and black, and immediately won the admiration of the team. Coach Wells purchased it right then and there. The cat spent the evening with the team in the Rose Room of the Barnes Hotel for the banquet, which was hosted by Mr. and Mrs. O.L. Harrington.

Tucker's story was validated by Curly Hupp's daughter, Nancy (Hupp) Wallis of the class of 54'.

Felix did not make it onto the floor until the 1926-27 season, Tucker and Hupp's senior year. After Felix made his first appearance, thanks to Curly, he was often brought to the floor in later games that season by LHS yell leader Henry "Hank" Muckenfuss.

Felix had been replaced six or seven times. The last stuffed Felix figure to be placed out on the floor is now housed in the Cass County Historical Museum.

Felix IV was submitted to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame Museum in New Castle in 1986, where he is on display today.

Though still highly revered, the figure has given way to a live version of Felix who interacts with fans, dances on the floor, and enlightens children and adults alike. A community fundraiser was held in 2000-01 to purchase a new Felix costume. The new costume was unveiled to Berry fans during Felix's 75th Birthday Celebration on January 19, 2001.

On Friday, December 16, 2016, Logansport High School celebrated the 90th Birthday of Felix the Cat as the oldest mascot in the state of Indiana. The celebration took place in the Berry Bowl, in conjunction with the girls/boys varsity basketball only double-header vs. Lafayette Jeff. There were activities in the auxiliary gym for children of all ages, and a photograph session with Felix as well. Boomer from the Pacers, Charlie Cardinal from Ball State, Rowdie from the Indianapolis Indians, as well as other high school mascots from around the state, were in attendance for the celebration.

As part of celebrating the 90th Birthday of the Oldest Mascot in the state of Indiana, Felix the Cat, Logansport High School was honored to bring the "Felix the Cat Guy" Don Oriolo, to Logansport.

Don is the son of Joe Oriolo, the protégé of Felix creator, Otto Messmer and producer of the 60's Felix tv series, in doing so creating Poindexter and the magic bag. Near the end of his career, Joe Oriolo, recognizing his son Don's imagination and passion for Felix, and his incredible success in the entertainment business, asked Don to bring their beloved Felix into the twenty-first century.

Don did a community event the night before the celebration in the McHale Performing Arts Center. He told all about the history of Felix the Cat's creator Otto Messmer, Don's father, Joe Oriolo and much more. In fact, Joe Oriolo created that famous friendly ghost, Casper! Don sang some songs, drew Felix, told stories and much more!

The Birthday of Felix the Cat was an officially recognized Indiana Bicentennial event.

Nickname Berries

Just like there are different theories with the birth of Felix the Cat as the LHS mascot, the nickname the Berries has found itself shrouded in conjecture.

Until the mid-1920's, the basketball team, along with the other sports except football, were often called the "Red and Black." In addition, the basketball team was sometimes referred to as the "Wellsmen" after Coach Wells. From the early 1920's until 1955, the LHS football team was known as the "Red Devils." Due to some rivalry over the years among teams as LHS in having two nicknames, Berries and Red Devils, the "L" Club, an organization made up of boys who earned varsity letters in various sports, voted unanimously on October 3, 1955 to change the football name to the Berries. From that point forward, all sports teams at LHS were known as the Berries.

There is no definitive answer as to how LHS transitioned to the nickname Berries. The first known mention of "Loganberries" was found in a December 5, 1922 Pharos Tribune article. There was mention now and then up to the 1925-26 season. During the first part of the 1925-26 basketball season, the basketball team was still referred to as the "Red and Black." During December of that season, the name Berries started to become commonplace in the local papers.

The real loganberry is a hybrid of a wild blackberry and red raspberry which was developed in 1881 by lawyer and horticulturist James Logan. According to the Pharos Tribune, weeks prior to the Feb. 8, 1927 dedication game of the new gym versus LaPorte, Kokomo Dispatch sportswriter, Jean Graffis, suggested that the new LHS Gym be called the "Berry Bowl." This nickname was later adopted by the Pharos Tribune. In a February 3, 1927 Pharos Tribune article, basketball player "Lefty" Evans acting on the team's behalf, called the newspaper to inform them that the team would be very pleased if the new gym was called "Berry Bowl." The old "Berry Bowl" closed after the 1973 season.

Other theories say the name came from a popular saying during the 1920's, "That's the berries", meaning that's the best. Another theory says the name came from the Berry Patch, the former Logansport football field at Tower Park. That field did not open until the fall of 1929 well after the name was already being used. No matter what the actual story of when and how LHS became known as the Berries, alumni through generations that have gone on to college or moved away often get a similar reaction when people ask where they are from, "Oh, you guys are the Berries!"

In June 2020, the nickname Berries won the *Indiana Sports Talk* Nickname Mania Tournament, defeating the Frankfort Hot Dogs in the championship final.

LHS Emblem

The original emblem was designed during a 1933 *Magpie* contest. Martha Latz (33') received first place and \$2.00 for her design on the condition that some of Howard Hall's (33') features would be incorporated into her final design. Hall received second and \$1.00 for his contributions. The emblem appeared on the 1933 Tattler cover.

The school emblem reads "Logansport High School" around its edges, and has the letters "L.H.S." printed boldly on its face. Though many believe that the abbreviation, "L.H.S." only stands for the name of our school, this is not true. Those letters on the inside of our emblem have a banner attached to each one:

LHS Flag

The official flag was selected in 1964 from more than 50 entries in a contest sponsored by the Student Council. The flag's designer, 1964 graduate Russ Bridenbaugh, created a flag with the school seal on the left lying on a white triangular field pointing to the right. The upper portion of the remainder of the flag is black and the lower portion is red.

"The flag is simple but has a certain elegance about it, and I believe conveys exactly what it should say... 'This is our motto and these are our colors,'" said Bridenbaugh, who went on to earn a B.S. degree from Ball State University and a J.D. degree from Indiana University.

Russ was honored on January 31, 2014 at a home girls basketball game. Thank you Russ for your outstanding contribution to our school and the legacy of its tradition.
