As we continue to navigate these uncharted waters due to COVID-19, Seacoast Christian Academy is taking steps to ensure our students and staff return to school in the safest method possible while ensuring the best educational opportunities for each student. If a health, weather or other emergency forces the closing of the school for an extended period of time we have a detailed plan for continuing to provide a quality education for our student

We have developed this plan based on parent survey responses, current CDC guidelines, local government directives, and recommendations from the Florida Department of Education. Each scenario will strategically ensure that your child(ren) will thrive in the comfort and consistency of continuing to receive an excellent, well-rounded Christian education.

### **Middle and High School**

- **Option 1: Hybrid — On Campus & Mobile Learning\***

A combination of live, on-campus classes and mobile learning

\*Students can participate in live classes from alternate locations, either supervised on-campus locations or off-site (from home or another location).

- **Option 2: Resume School 100% on Campus upon request**

Preferred scenario for elementary grades; mobile learning option will be available for families who are more comfortable with their child(ren) learning offsite.

### **Elementary Grades K - 6**

100% on campus, with daily, in-person instruction in their respective classrooms. Safety precautions will be put in place such as teachers wearing clear face-shields, students using facemasks, ongoing cleaning and sanitizing, and proper hygiene practices. Desktop plexi-shields have been ordered and will be used as soon as we receive them.
