

Students are required to have phones secured so that they are not visible. They must be on silent or turned off from7:30-4:00. If a student does not comply or if the phone rings or makes some other sound, then the staff member will confiscate the phone. Students will text their parent to let them know they were not following the cell phone rules established, the teacher will verify the text, and the confiscate the phone.

First offense – staff member will confiscate phone and turn it into the Assistant Principal's office, the parent can pick up the phone the following day

Second offense and every other thereafter – staff member will confiscate phone and turn it into the Assistant Principal's office, the parent can pick up the phone the following day and pay a \$15 fee

Dress code policy

The full dress code for grades 7-12 is on the high school webpage. Every student that registers for Needville Junior High School and attends class is responsible for the entire dress code. Some highlights follow.

- 1. Shirts are to be tucked in. Girls that wear slacks or skirts can wear a blouse untucked as long as the blouse fits dress code. If jeans are worn, then the shirt must be tucked in.
- 2. Pants with belt loops must be worn with a belt.
- 3. Boys' hair shall <u>NOT</u> cover any part of the ears, be beyond the eyebrows, or extend over the top of a standard collar in the back when combed down (even when not wearing a standard collar). *The* student will be assigned discipline and have 2 days to comply or be assigned ISS.
- 4. Boys must be clean-shaven daily with NO facial hair visible. The student will shave immediately and receive discipline.
- 5. Extreme hair-dos of any nature as determined by the principal or his designee are NOT allowed.
- 6. Students must follow dress code while at school sponsored events. At outdoor events, students may wear long shorts that approach the knees and boys may wear caps as they are designed to be worn. SHIRTS must be in dress code and tucked in. At indoor events, students must be in dress code with shirts tucked in.

If a student attends an event and is not in dress code, they will not be allowed to stay at the event.

- 7. The wearing of any type of pierced jewelry anywhere on the body is <u>NOT</u> allowed except for girls wearing earrings in their ears.
- 8. Frayed or un-hemmed pants will not be permitted. Pants with holes are not permitted Any offense for any dress code violation student must be in dress code to attend class (or will remain in ISS) as well as receive after school detention. If after school detention is not ful Frayed or un-hemmed pants will not be permitted. Pants with holes are not permitted filled, the student will be placed in ISS.
