



Highlights of the Back to School Plan

- School begins Tuesday, August 11. [Link to 2020-2021 School Calendar](#)
- **Student arrival time is 7:45 a.m. Students may not arrive or be dropped off earlier than 7:45 a.m.** The schools will not be open until this time to lessen the congregation of students in common areas.
- Dismissal time remains the same.
- Masks are recommended, and not required at this time. There may be times during the day when wearing a mask will be an appropriate safety measure for students and staff. For example, on the bus or when closer than six feet from others.
- All students and staff will be given a face shield and a couple of reusable masks. Parents will need to wash the masks. (See the IDOE Handout for care of masks)
- All buildings will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to the first day of school, throughout each school day, and at the end of each school day.
- Handwashing, hand sanitizing, and proper hygiene tips will be emphasized. Schools will allow more time for restroom breaks and handwashing throughout the day.
- Cafeteria seating will be arranged to allow for social distancing during breakfast and lunch.
- Students may bring water bottles or may purchase water for 25 cents for a 16 oz. bottle that will be sold during breakfast and lunch.
- Parents are encouraged to go to EZ Pay to pay for meals so that students do not have to handle money during breakfast or lunch.
- Contact your principal for information about an online learning option if you feel it is necessary to limit your child's contact with others, due to medical concerns of students or family members.
- Online Registration opens Tuesday, July 14. Go to the milan.k12.in.us and click the link to begin.
- Go to Lunch App to complete the registration for free and reduced lunch and textbook assistance.
- TeleHealth Services will be offered again this school year. Interested families must complete the online registration form. We will send information about this form when it is ready for you.
