Student Eligibility for Extracurricular Activities

Sports

Initial eligibility for football, cross country and volleyball will be based upon the 1st report card. If a student is not eligible he/she will have two weeks to become so.

Initial eligibility for basketball will be based upon the 2nd report card. Continued eligibility will be based upon subsequent report cards.

If a student becomes academically ineligible* to participate in an extracurricular activity he/she will have a maximum time of 2 weeks to remove themselves from the probation list. The student may regain their eligibility before the 2 week period as long as their grades improve. If, however their grades do not improve by the end of the 2 week period, then they will be off the team for the remainder of the season.

The Athletic Director will be in contact with the teachers and the coaches during the probation period to determine if the grades have increased.

All coaches will present this information to the students and parents during an informational meeting, at which time written contracts will be completed to ensure clear communication of eligibility rules.

Ski Program

Initial ski program eligibility is based upon the 3rd report card. Subsequent report cards will determine continued eligibility. If a student becomes academically ineligible, he/she will have a maximum time of 2 weeks to regain eligibility. As with the Home Street's sports policy, if the skier/snowboarder is unable to regain eligibility during the 2 weeks allotted, he/she will be removed from the Ski Program for the remainder of the ski season.

***Academically ineligible = GPA less than 2.0 or an 'F' grade or 2 or more 'U' marks. Based on academic &/or behavioral issues, administration may revoke privileges at any time.**
