| Thursday, July 23 rd | 12pm - 6pm | 3 rd grade, 4 th grade, 5 th grade, and 6 th grade |

- **If you have children in multiple grades, you may come on one day to register all of your children.
- **After July 23rd, you may bring information to the front office Monday through Friday from 8 – 2. If these times don't work with your schedule, please call the school at 662-285-4052 to set up a time or e-mail helpaes@choctawsd.ms

Required Paperwork:

- New Students - parents will be required to bring in a withdrawal form from their previous school, 2 proofs of residency, registration paperwork, birth certificate, and shot record.
- Returning Students - parents will be required to bring in 2 proofs of residency and registration paperwork.
- Pre-K Students - parents will need to bring in any missing paperwork (shot record/birth certificate) and 2 proofs of residency.

Residency Forms:

- Must be a combination of two of the following:
 - Electric bill, waste bill, mortgage/property deed, automobile registration, water bill, landline phone (no cell), apartment/home lease, gas bill, homestead exemption, or driver's license
- Must be from the month of July and/or August
- Residency forms must be in the parent/guardian's name

Safety Procedures:

- All parents will enter through the front entrance and will be checked for fever.
- After being checked, parents will report to the library to fill out/turn in paperwork.
**Registration packets can be picked up ahead of time in the school's front office or printed from the district webpage.
- A staff member will be placed outside the library door to monitor crowd size and social distancing practices.
- Masks are strongly encouraged but not required.
- Upon completing registration, parents will exit out of the 6th grade door to have one-way traffic.
