PLAN A

SCHOOL DISTRICT SCREENING PROTOCOL

In an effort to prevent the spread of communicable diseases, especially during a pandemic or public health crisis, the district may implement the following protocol to control and restrict access to school property, activities and events:

- 1. The district encourages parents, legal guardians, and all school employees to self-screen at home. See pages 2 & 3 for the CDC Screening List.
- 2. If a student or employee has a temperature of 100.5 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, the student or employee should remain at home until the individual has been free of fever for twenty-four (24) hours without fever reducing medication.
- 3. The district may screen any individual who enters a school facility which screening process may include taking temperatures, asking health-related questions, and isolating those that have symptoms of a communicable disease.
- 4. The district will adhere to guidelines set by local, state and federal health and safety guidelines when feasible.

OPEN HOUSE & VISITORS

- 1. BACK TO SCHOOL PK-4th Grades: No entry into buildings-Drive Thru Drop Off ONLY
- 2. BACK TO SCHOOL 5th-7th Grades: No entry into buildings-Drive Thru Drop Off ONLY
- 3. NO BACK TO SCHOOL 8th-12th Grades:
- 4. PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES PK-12th Grades scheduled by teachers, conducted via telephone or ZOOM meeting.
- 5. NO VISITORS in school buildings unless authorized by the building principal. (APPOINTMENT ONLY)

BUSES

- 1. Open Windows for airflow weather permitting.
- 2. Hand Sanitizer will be provided and required as a student enters the bus.
- 3. Temperature of each student will be taken as they enter the bus. Any student with a temperature of 100.5 will not be allowed on the bus.
- 4. The school will clean and disinfect the buses after morning and afternoon routes.

SCHOOL BUILDING

- 1. Masks/shields are recommended but not required for students and staff.
- 2. Daily Cleaning and then sanitizing of everything using the Victory Cordless Electrostatic sprayer.
- 3. Teachers will be required to sanitize desks and equipment in their classrooms several times a day. School will provide the disinfectant.
- 4. Hand Sanitizing stations will be in each classroom.
- 5. Washing hands will be required several times a day.
- 6. Water Fountains will NOT be in use. The school will provide water bottles to students that need one.

STUDENTS & STAFF ENTERING THE SCHOOL

- 1. All students are expected to have completed a home screening before going to school each and every day. Below is the CDC Screening List. If a student is ill, please contact the school and keep the child home.
 - A. Symptoms (CDC.gov)

People or children with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People or children with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Unexplained or new cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Unexplained muscle or body aches
- Unexplained headache

- New loss of taste or smell
- Unexplained sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea or abdominal pain
- Rash
- Bloodshot eyes
- Feeling extra tired

This list does not include all possible symptoms. If a yes answer was to any of the above questions-STOP! DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL and/or activities. Contact your medical provider. Employees notify your immediate supervisor.

2. Each student and staff member will have a required temperature check each day upon entering their school building/bus.

3. Any student who has a 100.5 temperature or above upon entering, will be isolated until picked up by a parent. The student who has a fever will not be allowed to come to school until fever is normal and free from ill symptoms for (24) hours.

BREAKFAST

- 1. All students will report to their classroom with breakfast in a grab-n-go format no earlier than 7:45 A.M.
- 2. No large gatherings allowed during this time.

LUNCH TIME

- 1. Social Distancing Guidelines will be followed.
- 2. Students will have access to hand sanitizer before their meal and afterwards.
- 3. Students will eat in their classrooms. (NO EATING IN THE CAFETERIA).

1. Social Distancing Guidelines will be followed. The New Gym, Old Gym, and designated outdoor areas will be used for PE classes.

ELEMENTARY PK-4th GRADES

- 1. We will do only GRADE LEVEL ACTIVITIES.
- 2. Breakfast will be in the classrooms from 7:35 A.M.-8:00 A.M.
- 3. PE in the New Gym, Old Gym, and designated outdoor areas. Students will attend only with their class room.
- 4. No pep assemblies/school wide gatherings will be held until further notice.
- 5. Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held virtually or by phone.

MIDDLE SCHOOL 5th-7th GRADES

- Bathroom breaks will be by section. No classroom transitions. Teachers will rotate.
- 2. Breakfast will be in the MS Students Homeroom from 7:35 A.M.-8:00 A.M.
- 3. No pep assemblies/school wide gatherings will be held until further notice.
- 4. Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held virtually or by phone.

HIGH SCHOOL 8th-12th GRADES

- Breakfast and lunch will be offered as a grab & go at the south HS entrance. Students will report to their 1st Hour after grabbing their breakfast from 7:35 A.M.-8:00 A.M. There will not be any congregating in the outside of the school building or the pavilion basketball court area.
- 2. No pep assemblies/school wide gatherings will be held until further notice.
- 3. Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held virtually or by phone.

SICK STUDENT/STAFF MEMBER PROTOCOL

- Any student or staff member who has a fever upon entering school or the bus, or one who develops fever and or symptoms of COVID-19 will be isolated. The student will need to be picked up by a parent or guardian. The student or staff member who has a 100.5 degree temperature or above will not be allowed to come to school for (24) hours from onset of the illness and must have been fever and symptom free.
- 2. Any student or staff member who is exposed to someone with the COVID-19 will have to stay home for 14 calendar days or negative COVID-19 test.

PLAN B

Should the district feel the need to implement Plan B due to a rise in COVID-19 Virus, The Administration will notify the Coyle School District.

SCHOOL SITES WILL BE SHUT DOWN FOR 24 HOURS for thorough cleaning and sanitization.

MASK or FACE SHIELDS

- 1. Masks or face shields will be required at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. If a student can't wear a mask they must have a note from a physician stating that fact.
- 3. Students will be allowed to remove masks when outdoors.

BUSES

1. NO BUSES WILL RUN ROUTES.

BREAKFAST

1. Continue the same as in PLAN A.

LUNCH

1. Continue that same as in PLAN A.

SANITIZING/CLEANING

1. Daily Cleaning and then sanitizing everything using the Victory Cordless Electrostatic sprayer.

PLAN C

EDUCATION

- 1. Coyle Schools will go to our VIRTUAL EDUCATION district wide until it is safe to return.
- 2. The decision to go VIRTUAL for our district will be made with the collaboration from the State Department of Education.

CLEANING & SANITIZING

1. Cleaning and sanitizing will continue.

CHILD NUTRITION (Breakfast & Lunches)

1. We will have a plan in place to provide meals daily to students. The drive-thru will be located on the North side of the cafeteria. Delivery will be at designated areas. More information will become available if the decision is to move to Plan C.
