BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS:

Parking Permit Forms will be posted online by July 20th or you can pick up the forms in the office starting July 20th. We will allow Seniors to purchase parking permits starting July 27th and Juniors starting July 28th. Forms must be complete when a student comes to purchase a parking permit.

Students in grades 8-12 will be allowed to pick up schedules and turn in Registration Packets/Residency on the scheduled days. Tours of campus will not be allowed at this time.

Students in 7th grade as well as newly enrolled students will be allowed to pick up schedules, turn in residency and registration packets. They will also be allowed to tour the campus with one parent/guardian. All visitors are asked to wear a mask while touring the campus and speaking with teachers. **COME TO THE TY COBB FOYER!**

August 10th from 3 pm-6 pm—Our Office Staff will be available to answer questions and give out schedules. We will be in the new building.

Plans and Procedures:

- Class sizes will be reduced to 20 students or under (with the exception of extracurricular classes)
- Social Distancing will be practiced in the classrooms
- Breakfast/Break/Lunch will be in the classrooms
- Sanitizing stations will be set up in the hallways and hand sanitizer will be available in the classrooms
- Hallways will be sanitized between classes
- Classrooms will be sanitized between classes
- Bathrooms will be sanitized at least two times per day
- Stations will be set up to quarantine students with symptoms
- We will check temperatures when the students get to school before they enter the buildings. Only one entrance will be available in most buildings
- Masks will be worn if social distancing is not possible (in the hallways, in the restrooms, etc.)
- Students will report to their first period class at the beginning of the day
- Car Riders—
 - JH Drop off (exception D Building students)—at the Ty Cobb
 - HS Drop Off—Circle Parking Lot on main campus
 - Pick ups will be at the same location—JH and HS will have staggering bells (same as bus)

During the School Day:

Tardy Bell will ring at 7:40.

Stretch Break—We will have a stretch break between 2nd and 3rd period to allow students time to go by the restroom and purchase a snack on the way to 3rd period. These will be set up in each building.

Lunch—

We will deliver to the classrooms.

Each morning the students/teachers (if needed) will fill out a basic survey (questionnaire) to ask about lunch:

For example: They will pick one choice Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday

- Blue Plate—Meatloaf, Mashed Potatoes, Carrots, Fruit Cup, Roll, Milk
- Charger's Choice—Chicken Sandwich, French Fries, Carrot Sticks/Dip, Fruit, Milk
- Salad—Tuna Salad, Crackers, Fruit, Milk
- Not eating lunch from the cafeteria

Brown Bag Lunches will be served on Wednesday.

This will also include the student's/teacher's name and lunch number (student).

We will have contactless payment (pay online, send money in the mail, or they can drop off payment in an envelope at breakfast).

Breakfast—

The students will use an outside entrance to pick up a Grab'N Go Breakfast. They will report to their first period class after they pick up breakfast.

Supply List:
