POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

UNEXPIRED TERM FULFILLMENT/VACANCIES

When a vacancy occurs on the school board for any of the following reasons, the vacancy shall be filled by all school board members, including the vacating member:

- Failure to elect a person to succeed a school board member whose term has expired
- An elected school board member's failure to qualify
- A school board member's resignation

When a vacancy occurs on the board for any of the following reasons, the remaining board members are responsible for the appointment of a new school board member:

- Death of a school board member
- A school board member is removed from the board pursuant to law
- A school board member ceases to be a resident of the school district or representation area where elected
- A school board member is convicted of any infamous crime or of any offense involving a violation of the member's official oath
- A school board member has a judgment obtained against the member for breach of the member's official bond
- A school board member is incapacitated and is unable to attend to the duties of the position
- A school board member assumes the duties of an office incompatible with the duties of a school board member
