

SCHOOL BOARD GOVERNANCE AND OPERATIONS

QUORUM

A majority of the members of the entire School Board at any legally called meeting shall constitute a quorum. A seven member board requires four members present, either in person or via live electronic means, to conduct business.

Assent of a majority of the members of the School Board shall be required to take any official action as a School Board.

In the event that Board members are absent or that Board members must abstain from voting due to conflict of interest, Board action may be taken only if it is approved by the majority of members which, on a Board of seven members would be four members.

All official acts of a School Board relative to motions or resolutions passed at School Board meetings become effective at the time of such passage unless otherwise expressly provided therein.
