TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

It is the policy of the Aberdeen School Board to accept responsibility for a student transportation program and to provide reasonably safe, appropriate, and efficient transportation for all its students whenever they ride in district-approved vehicles. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall provide administrative guidelines that define the student transportation program.

The School District shall provide transportation at public expense for K-8 students residing more than five (5) miles from their attendance center under provisions of state laws and School Board regulations. An eligible student is one who attends a school within boundaries assigned based upon physical residence. Free transportation will not be provided for students granted an indistrict transfer. The School Board will set the standard of service. Primary mode of service shall be busing. Parents/guardians retain the option of providing transportation at their expense. Under this policy any parents/guardians' rights are protected by due process procedures.

Students from birth to twenty-one, certified as needing special education or special education and related services may be provided transportation as determined by a placement committee and addressed on a student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

The School District may provide transportation services in the support of academic and cocurricular programs of the District.

The School District may provide transportation services to K-8 students living between two and one half (2.5) miles and five (5) miles from their attendance centers for a fee established by the School Board. The students must be living within the boundary assigned by the District and must be living on an established route.
