HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

The purpose of homebound instruction is to provide an alternative education while a student is experiencing a significant medical condition for an extended period. Homebound instruction may be considered when the student's medical condition puts the student at risk from attending school in person.

Home/hospital bound instruction for students will be provided in person or virtual. Instruction will be provided by a home/hospital bound instructor or a classroom teacher who will provide instruction at times agreed upon by the parents/medical provider. If the classroom teacher provides instruction, it will be done after regular school hours on days of student attendance in accordance with the school calendar. In-person services will not be provided in cases where the condition of the student might endanger the health or safety of the teaching staff.

Courses will be consistent with those provided in the regular school setting.
