CURRICULUM PROGRAMS

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT POLICY REGULATIONS

- 1. Any student in grades 11 or 12 may enroll in not more than nine (9) credits per fall or spring semester which are offered at an institution of higher education or postsecondary vocational educational institution.
- 2. The student shall obtain the Aberdeen School District's approval of the postsecondary course prior to enrolling in the course(s).
- 3. If approved, the student shall receive full credit toward high school graduation as well as post-secondary credit for the course(s). Post-secondary courses at the 100 or 200 level will be calculated using the 4.5 scale and courses at the 300 level or higher will be calculated using the 5.0 scale.
- 4. All post-secondary credits earned will be transcripted as an elective unless approved by the principal or his/her designee.
- 5. The Aberdeen School District will not be responsible for any costs incurred for tuition, fees, textbooks, etc. by the student.
- 6. If a failing grade or withdrawal is received in the post-secondary courses in which the student is enrolled, the student is no longer eligible to enroll in future post-secondary courses while in high school absent a showing of good cause.
- 7. If the student drops from a post-secondary course he/she must notify the high school principal or his/her designee immediately.
