	POLICIES AND REGULATIONS	

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

Children of school age who are residents of Aberdeen School District 6-1 may attend school without payment of tuition.

Children who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet all of the following requirements:

- The child resides with his/her parents or legal guardian within the boundaries of Aberdeen School District 6-1.
- The child is in the United States under a visa other than a visitor's visa or a student visa; and
- The child is a participant in a foreign student exchange program approved by the Superintendent.
- The child is residing in a foster home on a permanent or temporary basis within the District.
- The child of an active duty military parent or guardian who resides or will reside within the District. The child is eligible to be enrolled with a state-approved distance-learning provider by the school district in which the parent or guardian will reside. A military installation is a base, camp, post, station, yard, center or other installations under the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Defense.

The School Board has the legal authority to determine which school a student will attend. Generally, students will be required to attend school in the attendance area in which they reside, unless special permission has been granted at the discretion of the Superintendent or his/her designee. The residence of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) will determine the legal address.
