STUDENT PHYSICALS FOR SCHOOL ATHLETICS

Students wishing to take part in interscholastic athletics must have on file with the School District a copy of a physical examination performed by a qualified health care provider. Physicals are required on a tri-annual basis. During the second and third years of the tri-annual physical period, an Interim Pre-Participation History form must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and, if necessary, a qualified health provider.

Parents and guardians are responsible for their child receiving a physical examination at their own expense with use of the proper forms. These forms must be properly completed and signed by the parent/guardian and attending health care provider. Physical examinations for students must be conducted after April 1 to be considered applicable for the tri-annual physical status.

No student shall be denied participation in interscholastic athletics due to a hardship surrounding the payment of a nominal fee for the physical examination.
