Safety Management Plan

Working with local authorities each site will have on hand a site specific Safety Management Plan which will be practiced by students and staff. These guidelines are to be designed at the District level and maintained annually by the building administrator.

Areas covered in the Safety Management Plan are:

- Abduction/Kidnapping/Missing Student
- Accident/Serious Injury/Illness
- Allergic Reactions
- Assault with Serious Injury/Rape/Sex Offense
- Bioterrorism
- Bomb Threat/Threat Calls
- Bus Accident
- Child Abuse/Neglect
- Contagious Disease
- Death
- Emergency During a Large Event
- Explosions
- Fights
- Fire
- Hazardous Materials/Chemical Spill
- Hostage Situation
- Intruder with Weapon
- Medical Emergency
- Nuclear Warning
- Plane Crash
- Severe Weather (Tornado, Flood, Earthquake, Natural Disaster)
- Shots Fired/Drive-by Shooting
- Suicide Intervention
- Trespassing
- Utilities Failure/Power Outage

In the event of an emergency, the Aberdeen School District's procedures and guidelines are outlined to assist staff members in dealing with the situation. The purpose of the Safety Management Plan is to maintain a unified and predictable plan of action by school personnel in the event of an emergency.

The objectives of the Safety Management Plan are:

- To assure safety and welfare of students and staff.
- To communicate with staff, students, parents and community through the most effective and practical manner.
- To meet special needs of students and staff affected by a crisis.
- To enable a building to continue instruction and carry out established routines, rules and regulations.
