2.	Three sets of key factors will be considered in the selection of materials. They are:
	 a. Meets high standards in literary, artistic, and aesthetic quality; technical aspects; and physical format. b. Is appropriate for the subject area and for the age, emotional development, ability level, learning styles, and social, emotional, and intellectual development of the students for who the materials are selected. c. Incorporates accurate and authentic factual content from authoritative sources.
3.	The District subscribes to the principles expressed in the American Library Association's Library Bill of Rights. It is the responsibility of the school board to provide a wide range of materials at different levels of difficulty and representing different points of view. Trained library personnel will provide materials on opposing viewpoints on controversial issues to enable students to develop necessary critical thinking skills to be discriminate users of information and productive members of society.
