PURPOSE

To provide meals to Randolph Central students that may experience food insecurity on weekends during the school year.

WHAT IS PROVIDED IN EACH STUDENT'S BAG

2 Breakfasts; 2 Lunches; 2 Dinners; 2-4 Snacks; Fresh Fruit if Available

NUMBER SERVED

For the 2022-2023 school year 165 students have been served each week.

COST/INFO

- The cost per student each week is approximately \$5.00.
- Our Student Support Specialists make this happen with the help of volunteers. Pam Green leads the effort to assemble the food bags weekly if you would like to assist call Willard Elementary and leave a number for Pam to call you back.
- Food items are donated or bought at reduced cost through Second Harvest, purchased at discounted cost through our food service department, and bought at Wal-Mart.
- NO OVERHEAD; ALL DONATED FUNDS GO DIRECTLY TO PURCHASE FOOD.

GOAL

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is to provide weekend meals to 200 students each week. **The total cost to provide 200 students with weekend meals for 36 weeks at \$5.00 per bag is \$36,000.** We cannot do this without donations. Granting organizations will help initially but most will not provide funding beyond their initial donation. Please help us feed our Randolph Central kids!
