## **Hybrid (In-person/Remote) Option**

Students enrolled in our hybrid option will follow the same calendar as all other GUSD students and will begin school on August 17, 2020. Students enrolled in the hybrid option will be enrolled in GUSD and will be given all rights and benefits afforded to a student attending in a 'tradition' in-person manner. For instance, students will be able to still participate in academic and athletic clubs and teams as long as it is safe to do so.

What can families expect while learning in a hybrid environment? Students will participate in the same learning they are used to, but in a hybrid/mixed learning environment. Students will alternate between in-person learning and remote learning throughout the week. Students will be assigned to an "A" or "B" schedule and will attend school on alternating days (i.e.: Mondays/Wednesdays or Tuesdays/Thursdays) to assist in ensuring fewer students on campus and to help maximize physical distancing. Students will then learn from home/remotely on days they are not on campus. In the remote portion of the week, students will participate in age and subject appropriate supplemental learning material (this could be online, teacher-led instruction, packets and worksheets, etc.). Students will practice what they learned in person while learning remotely.

Students are asked to commit to the hybrid learning option for at least one trimester (exceptions may be made on an individual basis).

Please note that elements to this plan may be subject to change based upon new information and guidance from state and health agency partners. We will share updates/changes as they become available.

## The hybrid student experience:

- On the bus (if needed):
  - Drivers, monitors and riders will be required to wear a face covering and will be subject to temperature checks.
  - o Students will sit in assigned seats when possible.
- Students will be assigned to the "A" or "B" schedule. It is the intention that family units will be given the same schedule even if family members attend different schools. Students will attend school in-person on their assigned days. On the remaining days, students will engage in remote learning.
- On days when students are on campus, the student will be marked present when they arrive at class (and/or each class period if a HDMS or GHS student) daily and on-time. On their remote learning days, students will be marked present through completed assignments, parent attestation and/or logging into a computerized program (depending upon class, age, appropriate scenario).

- On in-person learning days, students will experience a typical school day with enhanced health and safety measures.
  - Copper Rim hybrid students will be in classes with other hybrid learners with the intent of little interaction with four-day learners.
  - Masks/shields/face coverings will be required to attend class in-person per the Mayor of Globe's proclamation and safe standards. Teachers will allow for 'mask/shield' breaks as needed, appropriate and when physical distancing standards can be maintained.
  - Students and staff will undergo health checks when arriving on-campus which will include temperature checks, observation and health questions.
- Meal Service is available for students that choose the hybrid learning option. Meals will have to be picked up at designated locations within the district.
- Parents are encouraged to actively participate in student learning to assist our schools with ensuring student participation, attendance and course completion.
- Students may participate in extracurricular activities following health and safety guidelines.
- Special education students will be provided with support in accordance with the Individualized Education Plan to every extent possible.
- Information on state testing will be shared with students and families after the beginning of the school year.
