Snow Plowing/Removal/Sanding Specifications:

1. The primary contact for the district will be D.J. McNamer, Buildings and Grounds Supervisor. He may be reached at the following numbers: 627-0113 (voice mail); 608-305-4815, work cell, or 608-606-1805, cell. The secondary contact will be Douglas Olsen, District Administrator, 627-0101 (work); 606-1675 (cell).

2. This contract will begin immediately following the first snow. The successful contractor will meet with D.J. McNamer prior to the first snow to discuss the bid specifications.

3. For one (1) inch or less of accumulated snow, the driveway will be plowed and sanded/salted and the parking lot and walkway to the upper playground will be sanded/salted only. For more than one (1) inch of accumulated snow, the driveway, parking lot, and back of school, including the walkway to the upper playground, will be plowed and sanded/salted. **The walkway is to be plowed with a pickup truck only.**

The bus garage parking area will also be included for plowing/sanding, following the same specifications.

4. The site will need to be plowed by 6:00 A.M. for the start of school.

5. The contractor must be available for daytime snow removal, as well as nights and weekends.

6. The contractor will be provided a list of events and dates that will be going on during the school year.

7. The successful contractor will pay for their own fuel and repairs on their equipment.

8. The successful contractor will provide the school district with cell phone and/or land line numbers.

9. Any accumulations of plowed snow must be moved to an area on school grounds designated by D.J. McNamer. **REMINDER – Snow is not to be pushed into the drainage ditch surrounding the lower playground.**
