


**WALKER
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- **All teachers, staff, and students will be trained in proper sanitation and movement throughout the school.**
- **All children, staff, and volunteers will engage in handwashing upon arrival, before and after any type of food prep or eating, after bathroom use, after playing outdoors or in sand, after handling garbage, or if there is any visible soiling present.**
- **Handwashing posters will continue to be displayed near sinks.**
- **All staff members and visitors will wear a mask all day while on campus.**
“When developing policy regarding the use of cloth face coverings by students or school staff, school districts and health advisors should consider whether the use of cloth face coverings is developmentally appropriate and feasible and whether the policy can be instituted safely. If not developmentally feasible, which may be the case for younger students, and cannot be done safely (eg, the face covering makes wearers touch their face more than they otherwise would), schools may choose to not require their use when physical distancing measures can be effectively implemented. School staff and older students (middle or high school) may be able to wear cloth face coverings safely and consistently and should be encouraged to do so.” (COVID-19 Planning Considerations: Guidance for School Re-entry, American Academy of Pediatrics)
- **Preschool students are not required to wear masks.**
- **Signage will be posted at entrances and throughout buildings with the latest health guidance regarding frequent handwashing, cough etiquette, nose blowing, etc.**
- **Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized after each class is finished.**
- **Disinfecting equipment for teachers and staff will be liberally distributed.**
- **Tables and materials will be sanitized during transition times.**
- **Sanitation stations will be set up at various locations throughout the campus as determined by the principal.**
- **There are no planned assemblies at this time.**



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- **Meet the Teacher videos will be posted by individual teachers to their Teacher Pages.**
- **Video/Phone conferencing will be held with families prior to the start of school.**
- **Students/Parents/Guardians will attend a packet distribution drive-thru prior to the start of school.**
- **Students/Parents/Guardians will have assigned times to attend Parent-Teacher conferences via video/phone conferencing.**
- **Teachers will be on the lookout for illness and refer students to the nurse as needed.**
- **There will be a designated space for healthy students coming to the nurse's office for routine needs, medications, diabetic checks, asthma management, first aid/injury assessment, etc.**
- **Parents of students needing medication administered during school hours must call the school to schedule an appointment with the nurse.**
- **There will be a designated isolation space for students and/or staff who are ill or need evaluation for possible infection.**
- **Parents are instructed to keep students at home if they are ill.**
- **Parents should screen for the following before sending their student(s) to school each day:**
 - Unexplained cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, loss of taste or smell.
 - Close contact with infected person (COVID-19) within the previous 14 days.
 - Fever of 100.4 or above within the last 48 hours.
- **Any student or staff member with a fever of 100.4 degrees or greater or symptoms of possible COVID-19 virus infection should not be present at school.**
- **Persons having a fever of 100.4 will have to leave the facility immediately.**
- **A student with a fever of 100.4 or above, or showing any signs of COVID-19, will be separated with appropriate supervision.**



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- **The parent/guardian of a sick child will be contacted immediately to pick up the child.**
