








1. Will you send your child/children to school this fall given the current pandemic situation?

2. If you answered "Maybe/Unsure" to question 1, please choose the statement below that best describes your reasoning (then proceed to question 4).





4. How comfortable would your child/children be with wearing a face covering or mask to school?



5. Ideally, school will operate as close to normal as possible. If major modifications to the daily schedule are needed, which of the following would you prefer?



6. If school was forced to close again and we had to resort to remote learning, which of the following best describes your view of that?


